### Supporter sponsor (\$100)

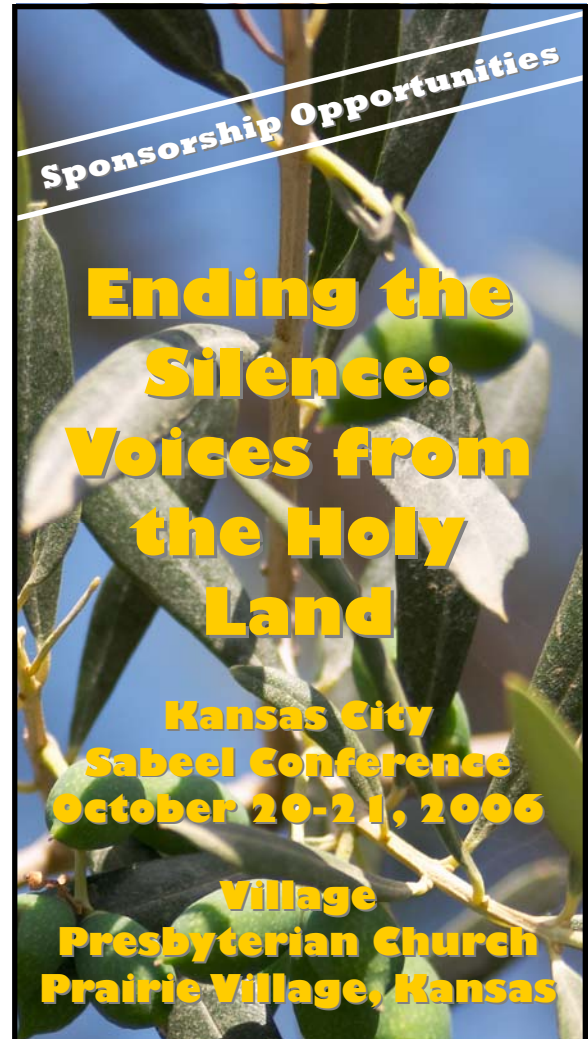
This entitles the donor to one complimentary admission to all conference activities, a business-card ad in the conference program plus a listing on the conference web site.
